OUR CHURCH HERITAGE



Prior to Ashby being incorporated as a town, the people

were required to meet in the town where they resided in order to be considered as voting citizens. This was one of the primary reasons for the formation of smaller towns as people began to settle further from their town centers making it difficult for people to attend church. The people who lived in what is now Ashby were living in Townsend, Lunenburg or Fitchburg. When Ashby was incorporated in 1767, the new town needed to organize a meeting place for church and town business. In 1779 they voted to build a meetinghouse on the site where the First Parish Church now stands. In 1809 the old meetinghouse was torn down and a new one was erected.

After the church split in 1819, the newly formed Ashby Calvinistic Congregational Church began to meet in the home of Jonathan Blood. The first building that the new church owned stood where the Ashby Library now stands. When this building proved to be too small it was sold to a group who opened an academy for education and a new building was built which is our present home. It was built in 1835 and dedicated in 1836.
